Class News – 20th June 2025

In **Little Leaners** we have had a magical week of unicorns, sparkles and rainbows! We have read unicorn stories, made our own magical horns, and even tried a bit of unicorn inspired maths. It's been a wonderful way to blend learning with imagination and a whole lot of glitter!

We have had another fantastic week in **Reception** Class! This week we have been learning about riddles in our English lessons. The children have been solving riddles about animals and exploring how riddles start with a tricky clue and each new clue gives more information. Over the week the children have been planning their riddles about a zoo animal and we have had lots of fun learning new facts about these animals. Next week they will use their plan to write their riddles.

In Art this week **Year 1** did some printing with foam shapes. They used their knowledge of the artist's works we have looked at and created an artwork inspired by it by doing a repeated design using the shapes and changing the colours just like the artist's did. Their artworks came out looking beautiful and the children really enjoyed doing it. In Geography, the children have been learning about the oceans over the world and were really good at remembering all the names of the different oceans. They listened to a song about the oceans and also sang along, it was good fun!

In **Year 2** this week we have been learning to sketch jungle animals thinking about shape, proportion and sketching techniques. In geography we have created a map with a key. We had a fantastic sports day where we all showed determination and resilience as well as great team work!

What a busy week we have had in **Year 4**! On Tuesday, we went on a walk through the village, looking at 'the wonder of one walk' with Miss Bussey. On Wednesday, we had our Roman Day (some great costumes!) where we learnt some Latin words and looked at different pictures of artefacts. In the afternoon, we made mosaics using squares of paper, it was lovely to see so many parents come and help their child. This is Daphne and a mosaic Stitch!



This week, in **Year 3**, we have learnt about magnetic force and investigated objects around the class to see which would be attracted to magnets. In History we looked at the Olympics in ancient Greece and modern day. We continued to recap our learning in Music from this year and in computing we learnt to animate sprites alongside getting them to play sound.

This week **Year 5** have done the beep test in PE, which was a challenge in the heat! We also have been rehearsing our junior play and we now have set every scene, how exciting!

Year 6 have been focusing on their writing. They edited older pieces, improving them by adding in more ambitious vocabulary, more varied sentence structure and higher level punctuation. They have also produced both fiction and non-fiction pieces with all of these skills.

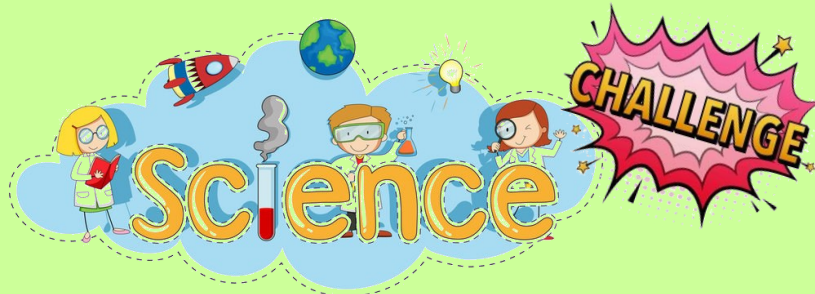

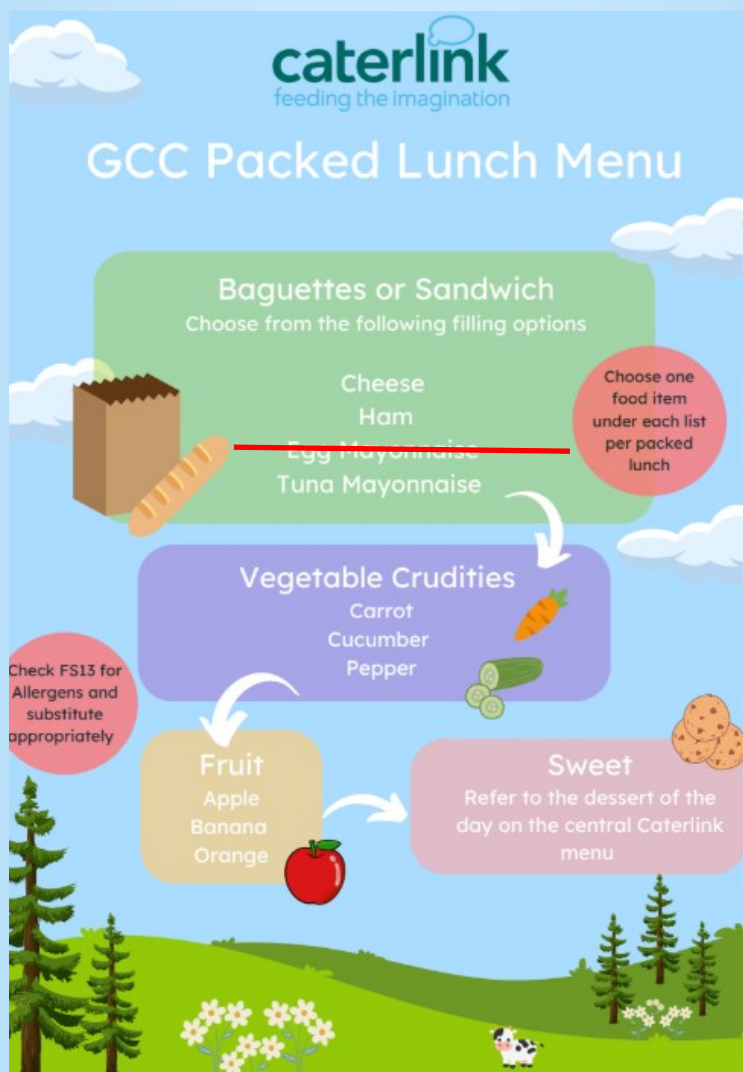

Apply online for free school meals



Check to see if your child is eligible using the confidential online portal available on our website www.gloucestershire.gov.uk/education-and-learning/free-school-meals/

You can secure a tasty free meal for your child and **save yourself up to £480 per year**. Plus your child's school receives extra funding for each eligible child registered.

If you receive a qualifying benefit, your child's school is entitled to extra funding. So even if you don't want your child to take a free meal, you should still apply to make sure that their school receives all the government funding to which it is entitled - helping them provide your child with the best education and support.

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 already receiving an Universal Infant Free School Meal arranged by their school will still have to apply to enable their school to get any extra funding. If you do not have access to a computer or the internet, speak to your child's school.
