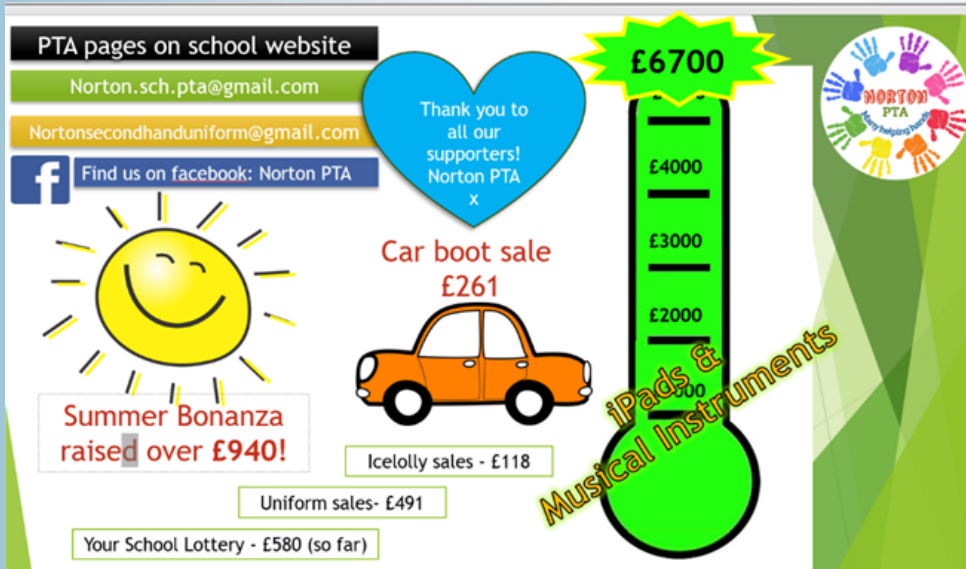


Weekly Newsletter – 26th June 2025

Class News – 26th June 2025

It's been another fun and busy week in **Little Leaners** as we blasted off into our exciting space topic! The children had a fantastic time getting creative as we painted colourful solar systems, suns, and rockets. We also brought space into our Maths activities, and the children practiced their cutting skills crafting their own rockets.

It's been wonderful to hear the children confidently sharing what they already know. Their curiosity and enthusiasm for space is amazing.

We also enjoyed many space-themed stories as the children brought them in to share with their friends.

This week in our My Happy Mind lessons, **Year 1** have been learning about the life cycle of a Human. The children discussed what happened at each stage (babies, toddlers, children, teenagers, adults and elderly). For example, babies cannot walk or talk and teenagers need to have more sleep! We also discussed our emotions and what may happen/what we look like when we feel these emotions. It was lovely to hear the children's mature ideas about their emotions and what they can do to help them when experiencing different emotions.

This week, **Year 3** we looked at the ancient Greek gods and goddesses and created fact files for them using our writing skills. In science, we used our knowledge of magnetic forces to make a magnetic fishing game!

This week in PE **Reception** have been on the move! We've been practising our fundamental movement skills through exciting athletics activities. The children have had a brilliant time running, jumping, balancing, and throwing — all while building their coordination and confidence. Whether it was racing across the running track or perfecting their superhero jumps, everyone gave it their all with big smiles and bundles of energy. Well done, Reception – future athletes in the making!

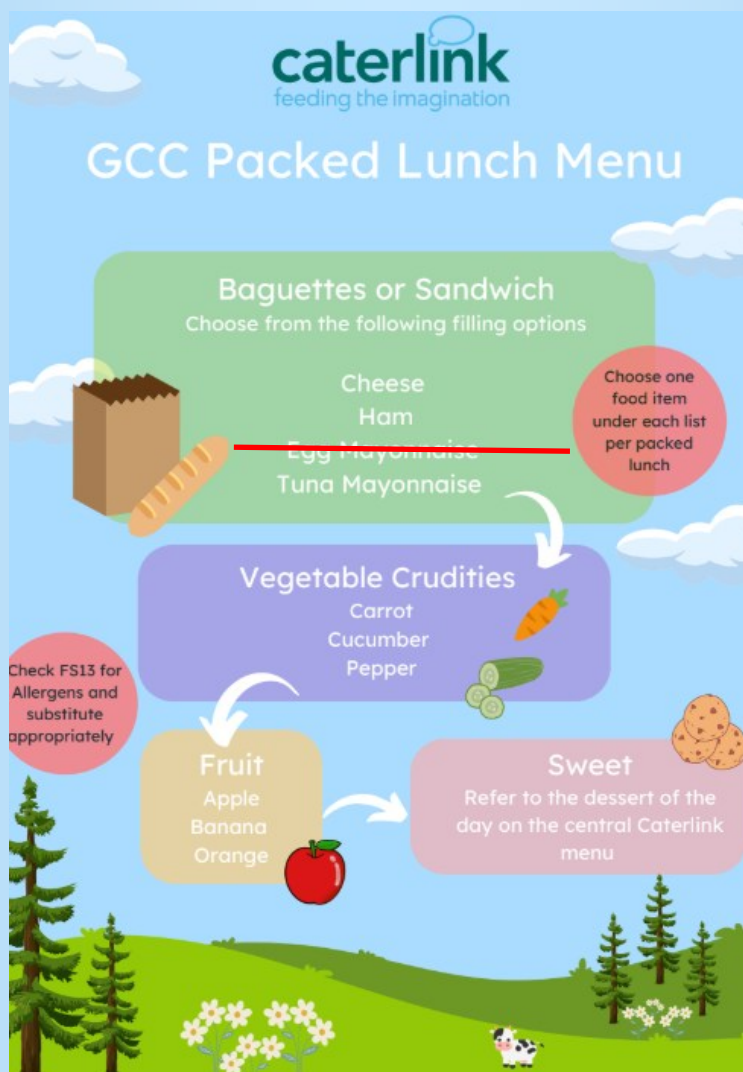

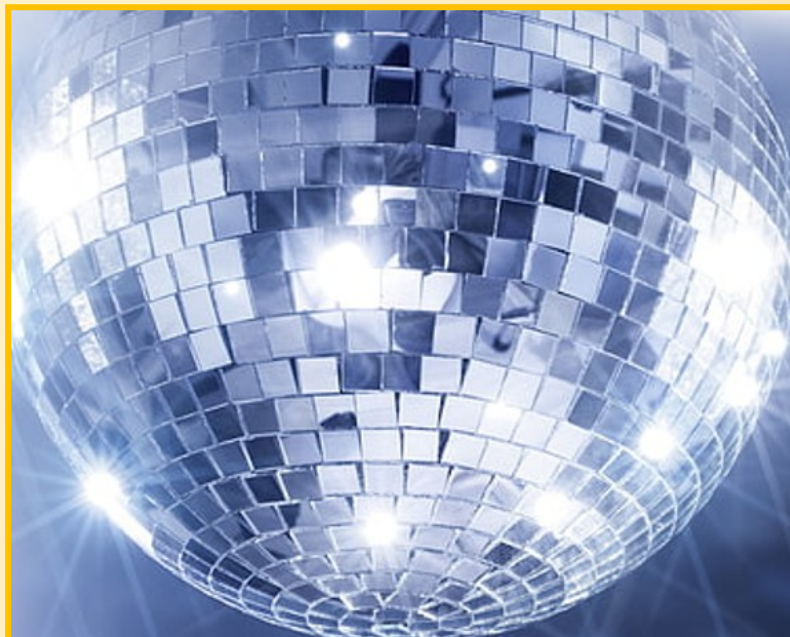

Apply online for free school meals



Check to see if your child is eligible using the confidential online portal available on our website www.gloucestershire.gov.uk/education-and-learning/free-school-meals/

You can secure a tasty free meal for your child and **save yourself up to £480 per year**. Plus your child's school receives extra funding for each eligible child registered.

If you receive a qualifying benefit, your child's school is entitled to extra funding. So even if you don't want your child to take a free meal, you should still apply to make sure that their school receives all the government funding to which it is entitled - helping them provide your child with the best education and support.

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 already receiving an Universal Infant Free School Meal arranged by their school will still have to apply to enable their school to get any extra funding. If you do not have access to a computer or the internet, speak to your child's school.
